Your Neighbourhood Talks

LLDC is holding its next Your Neighbourhood Talks event on Wednesday 27 September at the Building Crafts College on Kennard Road, E15 1AH.

The theme of this year's event is "Neighbourhood Priorities," which aims to shine a light on all of the incredible community activity that takes place on and around the Park.

Head to the Marketplace, where local organisations and businesses can informally talk to attendees about who they are and what they do on Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park and beyond. It is an invaluable opportunity for local residents and businesses to find out about the latest changes on





the Park, new plans for the area, how they might affect people and ways to get involved in the local community.

There will also be several interactive roundtable discussions, which are a great way to discuss local issues.

Topics will be centred around community activity, community spaces and jobs and skills. Anyone is welcome to join these roundtables which will be led by LLDC's Neighbourhood Priorities Fund projects and other local community initiatives.

New students on the Park

You might have noticed more students on the Park recently, as we start welcoming young people from UCL and London College of Fashion as East Bank, the new cultural and education district on the Park, starts to open up.

As part of this, the public realm area, which connects Stratford Walk to London College of Fashion, has recently opened. Works on Stratford Walk are nearly finished and will be completed by the end of December 2023.



Monier Road Bridge Works

Construction of the new connecting road between Monier Bridge and Bassett Lane / Sweetwater Place is now complete and the route is open fully to pedestrians and cyclists.

TfL and the London Borough of Tower Hamlets have started installing bus stops and signage, in preparation for the bridge to carry buses later this year.

Road closures in Hackney Wick

Road closures will be in place on White Post Lane, Rothbury Road and the surrounding area on Saturday 14 and Sunday 15 October. The closures will be put in place to enable the movement of the new Roach Point Bridge.

These closures are for storage purposes and not commencement of construction of the bridge. There will still be pedestrian access but this may be limited while the bridge is being transported over the weekend.

Westfield **Avenue Works**

Works to reconfigure Westfield Avenue will start in November 2023 and run until March 2025.

The upgraded road will make space for a dedicated, segregated, two-way cycle lane by narrowing the roadway from four lanes to two, making the road safer and more attractive to pedestrians and cyclists.

The works are being carried out by the London Borough of Newham and there will be disruption to the area while the works take place.
