Construction works update

The works on Stratford Walk - the entrance to the Park from Westfield - continue as new landscaping, benches and lighting are installed.

Stratford Walk is part of the preparation for East Bank which will start to open later in 2023. The hoardings that are in place around East Bank public realm will start to come down at the end of August, as we gear up towards welcoming 6000 students to the Park in the autumn.

Resurfacing works on the bridge by the fountains (bridge 1) and the bridge to Bobby Moore Academy

primary school (bridge 3) will take place over the summer; please follow the diversion routes that will be in place. The works on Sweetwater Place and along Carpenters Road will be finished over the summer.

This is the remaining piece of infrastructure that will be key to our work in connecting the Park to local neighbourhoods.

Enabling works and piling works for the latest phase at East Wick and Sweetwater are now complete. The main contract and above ground works are due to commence in the summer.
